Goals & Objectives

1. To implement the investigations curriculum
2. To develop mathematical thinking and reasoning
3. To develop a base for arithmetic skills

Materials

A variety of materials - depending on the unit of study

Activity (stations)

A variety of games, puzzles, objects are set out at 3 tables.
Students rotate to each table in small groups

Student Product

Students gain social skills, i.e. cooperation, flexibility, etc.

Students gain math skills, i.e. counting, sorting, patterning, measuring, etc.
